Den här grundboken i engelsk språkdidaktik handlar om texter av olika slag – skrivna, talade, digitala och visuella – och deras betydelse och användning i språkinlärning och språkundervisning.

Texttyper och genrer ges en framträdande plats, och författaren visar vad ett brett urval av texter kan betyda i språkklassrummet utifrån ett helhetsperspektiv på samtal, läsning och skrivande. Boken vänder sig främst till verksamma och blivande lärare i engelska inriktade mot grundskolans senare år, gymnasiet och komvux. Den erbjuder också värdefull läsning för lärare som undervisar i årskurserna 4–6 samt språklärare i andra ämnen.
